

Wabash Valley Road Runners 2012 Scholarship Application

The Wabash Valley Roadrunners Club, Inc. will award at least 2 scholarships of at least \$1,000.00 each for the 2012-2013 academic year. If there are qualified male and female applicants, at least one scholarship will be awarded to each gender. The winners will be selected this spring and will be recognized at their school's awards ceremony. Also, the winners will need to be present at the Wabash Valley Fast Track Mile in Terre Haute on July 4, 2012. This race funds the WVRR Scholarships. The scholarship funds will be submitted by WVRR to the institution's financial aid department on behalf of the award winner for use during the 2012-2013 academic year.

Qualifications:

Applicants must be high school seniors or full-time college students who are graduates from a high school in Vigo, Clay, Sullivan, Parke or Vermillion counties in Indiana or Clark or Edgar counties in Illinois. Applicants must be or have been accepted as a full-time student or presently be enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited four-year college or university, two-year college or university, community college or technical institution in the United States. High school applicants must be an active member of their high school cross country or track team participating in running events in their senior year and at least one other year or active members of a running club. College student applicants must have been an active member of the above mentioned high schools' cross country or track teams or an active member of a running club. The applicant must have a current grade point average of C or above and be a United States citizen. The scholarships will be awarded to students displaying exemplary behavior in all aspects of their lives, not just their athletic or academic accomplishments. The submitted application package covers a balanced range of important areas that present the applicant to the WVRR Scholarship Committee. It is important to stress that the submitted application package will be the primary tool for the selection committee to make their decisions. The application package information will be treated confidentially and will remain the property of WVRR. An individual may only receive a WVRR Scholarship once.

A checklist of items to be included in your application package:

___ Fully completed student information section.

___ Counselor information section to be completed by your school counselor.

___ A copy of your high school or college transcript.

___ A copy of your SAT or ACT scores.

___ Three (3) letters of recommendation: 1 from your high school or college track or cross country coach or running club representative; 1 from a teacher in your high school; 1 from a non-family member of the community in which you reside.

___ A personal essay of 400-500 words describing why you should receive this scholarship. The essay should include how running has impacted your life, your life goals and why this scholarship would be helpful to you.
